

Research Priority: Confirming Elimination

- a. Evaluation of programme results to date
- b. Determine which combination of indicators provide better evidence than current WHO recommendations to confirm interruption of transmission
- c. Determine specific SOPs to best measure the indicators in the population
 - Ongoing surveillance – clarify goals
 - MX – clarify targets and interpretation
 - Ab – clarify tools and targets

LF Surveillance: Proposed Next Steps

- Data review with WHO
 - Improved, provisional guidance
 - agree on which tools by phase
 - Testable protocols
- Modelling – sampling strategies; threshold determination for MX, vector density and antibody
- Multi-setting assessment of new tools and sampling strategies during TAS implementation
